

## TIRF 10-Point AI Ethics Guidance for Learners

- 1. Use AI tools for brainstorming and generating ideas.
- 2. Don't use Al output as your own work use it as an input for your own work.
- 3. Always cite the AI input you have used.
- 4. Check any AI output for accuracy or bias.
- 5. Ensure assignments are written in your own words.
- 6.Do not 'cut and paste' text from AI output into your written work except when cited as a quotation.
- 7. Do not try to copy AI output and simply paraphrase or re-write it, substituting some words and phrases this form of cheating can be detected.
- 8. The main arguments, content examples, and conclusion of your paper must be yours, and in your own words.
- 9. Do not use AI tools to create deepfakes or anything involving images or data about other people.
- 10. Copying text from an AI output, or any other kind of plagiarism, can result in suspension, reduced grades, oreven failing the course.
